I have another grandmother. She's my mother's mother and her name is Louise Hamilton. Her husband, my grandfather, is called³ James. They live in Brighton. My family and I always visit them in the summer holidays. They have got two daughters: my aunt Lisa Brown and my mum. Lisa's husband is Charles. They live in a house with Louise and James. Their son's name is Terry. He is fourteen years old. He is very good at skateboarding. But he also likes playing table tennis.

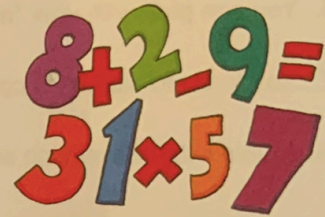

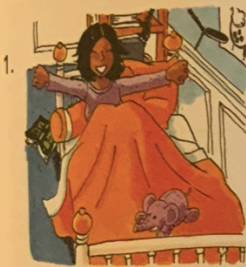
